



AE ENGINE WARRANTY INFORMATION

Associated Electrics, Inc. guarantees your AE engine to be free of defects and workmanship for a period of 90 days from date of purchase. For warranty verification, please keep your receipt in a safe place.

If we determine that an engine returned to us under warranty is defective in materials or workmanship, we will repair or replace the engine at our discretion.

This warranty covers defects in materials and workmanship, not problems from normal wear, abuse, neglect, or any damage arising as a result of improper use, use of improper fuel, overheating, continuous neglect, or damage from glow plugs.

Associated Electrics, Inc. shall not be liable for any loss or damages, whether direct or indirect, incidental or consequential, or from any special situation, arising from the use, or misuse, or abuse of this product, or any accessory or chemical relating to operating this product. (Two examples of this: We are not at fault if a vehicle powered by an AE engine causes collision damage, or if fuel used for the AE engine spills and ruins an item.)

The old AE engine must be returned complete with crankcase, crankshaft, piston, sleeve, connecting rod, cylinder head, carburetor, and pull starter. The AE engine should not include clutch, flywheel, flywheel collet and nut, air cleaner, manifold, or pivot ball on the throttle arm.
